




The Statement of Executive Director

As the new year approaches, I am delighted to present our 2023 annual report. The year 2023 was full of achievements for Medical Mercy Foundation, as we were able to reach a large segment of the most needy figures in Yemen, and provide them with support in the health and social fields. In addition to basic health services, the Foundation focused on the implementation of a number of specialized health projects, including: Malnutrition Treatment Project: More than one million beneficiaries have benefited from this project since 2016. The project included the provision of therapeutic nutrition, health awareness, and training of health workers and community health volunteers. Environmental Protection Project: This project aimed to protect the environment in Yemen by enhancing environmental awareness among local communities, improving natural resource management, and combating pollution. Mobile Medical Caravan Project for Hypertension and Diabetes: This project aimed to provide health care to patients with pressure and diabetes in remote areas. More than 1,000 beneficiaries have benefited from this project. Over the past year, we have faced many challenges, most notably: the continuing humanitarian crisis in the country, which has led to the displacement of ...









BSFP-Preventive Nutrition Program







The preventive nutrition program aims to protect children and women from malnutrition. It focuses on providing preventive nutritional support to groups whom most vulnerable to malnutrition, including:

Children under the age of five: This group is considered more vulnerable to malnutrition, as their nutritional needs are high.
Pregnant and breastfeeding women: This group needs additional amounts of nutrients to support the growth of the fetus and infants.



The Mobile Medical Teams Program for Malnutrition is a project that aims to provide health and nutrition care services to people living in rural and remote areas in Yemen. Screening children to identify cases of malnutrition.

- Providing therapeutic feeding treatment for children with acute malnutrition
- Providing basic health care to patients suffering from malnutrition or related diseases
- Providing guidance on healthy nutrition for parents Mobile medical teams target rural and remote areas in Yemen, where access to health services is difficult. Teams travel to villages and communities and set up temporary medical centers.

Since its launch in 2016, the Malnutrition Mobile Medical Teams Project has helped more than 3 million people in Yemen. The project contributed to a decrease in acute malnutrition rates in Yemen, saving the lives of many children.






Project Supporting Health Centers

A project of Health Centers Support is a project that aims to improve the quality of health services provided in health centers to poor and middle-income communities. The project focuses on providing financial and logistical support to health centers, including:

Medical Equipment: This includes the provision of medical equipment to provide basic health care, such as blood pressure and glucose meters, x-ray machines, etc.

Medicines: This includes the provision of medicines necessary to provide basic health care, such as medicines to treat infectious diseases, chronic diseases, etc.

Training: This includes training health workers in health centers on how to use medical equipment and provide basic health care.


MEDICAL CONVOY PROJECT FOR HYPERTENSION AND **DIABETES, FUNDED BY DIRECT AID - YEMEN**

The Medical Mercy Foundation carried out a medical convoy for diabetics and hypertension patients in Al-Maraw'ah District - Al-Hudaydah Governorate, as a part of its interest in the health conditions in the governorate, and providing medical and therapeutic services to those suffering from chronic diseases.

The campaign, which lasted for two days, aimed to examine medical cases, conduct medical examinations, and dispense free medicines.

The campaign provided medical and therapeutic services to more than 1,000 patients, supporting them with necessary medical examinations, dispensing free medicines, and necessary medical advice and guidance on how to take care of their health and control their blood sugar and blood pressure levels.

Environmental protection project

The Medical Mercy Foundation implemented a project on the impact of pollution on local communities and the environment in Hadramaut Governorate, funded by the Robert **BOSCH** Foundation.

The project aimed to know the impact of pollutants on local communities and the environment in Hadramaut Governorate, enhance environmental awareness among local communities, improve natural resource management, and combat pollution. Project activities included the following: Implementing a field study to find out the causes of pollution and its impact on the local community and the environment. Based on the results of the study, awareness campaigns and training courses were implemented in the Sah and Tarim districts. This included holding seminars and workshops for local authority offices (environment, health, agriculture and water) and local communities.


Implementing environmental awareness campaigns in the targeted areas through awareness messages via posters and local radio.
